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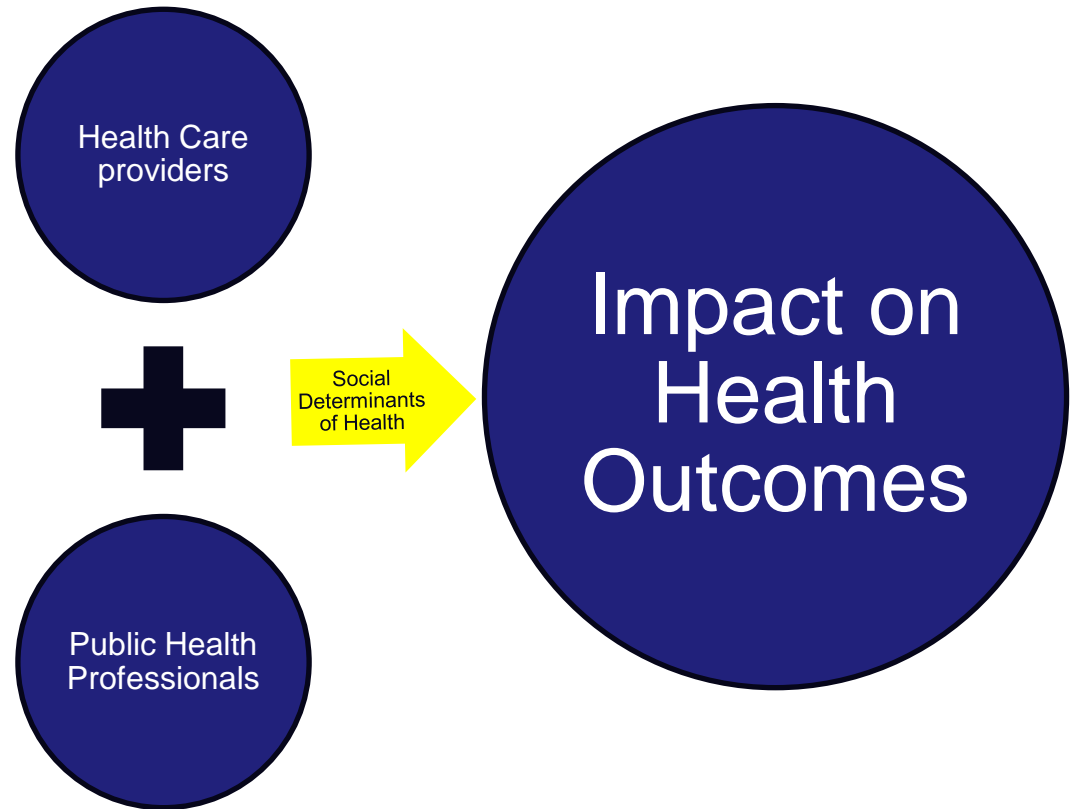

- Continuous process improvement

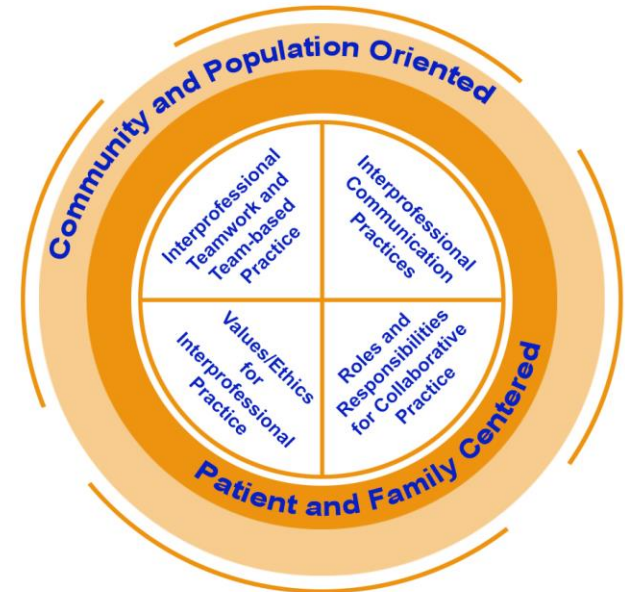
It is necessary to acknowledge that in most places, public health and health care don't yet recognize their overlaps and possibilities for mutual progress.

Focus	Individual health - clinic	Population health - public housing
Point of service (served entity)	Parent and child	Community - housing residents
Action for students	Treatment team - Clinical assessment and treatment of long-term sequela of lead poisoning and related SDOH	Housing Action Group - Advocacy on behalf of residents for policy change and practical interventions with community agency (housing Authority)
Simulation interaction	Student teams interview parent of two-year-old child	Student teams advocate with unresponsive/resistant Director of the Housing Authority
